Program Description:	Provide cost-effective, high-quality transportation services to eligible DC Veterans seeking transportation services throughout the District of Columbia and to approved Virginia and Maryland medical and social service facilities. An updated FY23 list of approved out-of-state facilities will be provided by the Mayor's Office of Veteran Affairs (MOVA) at the start of the project. Note: The VetsRide program does not currently identify any location restrictions within the District of Columbia. The awardee will need to develop, implement and maintain a dispatch system and application/online dispatch booking system for customers to pre-book trips up to 24 hours in advance and/or on demand. The dispatching system can be a smart phone

	application or web-based dispatch booking system for eligible customers, MOVA and DFHV program staffers may access twenty-four hours a day, seven days a week.
