Title: 2017 Presidential Inauguration
Special Event Limousine Decal

I. BACKGROUND & PURPOSE

Consistent with established practice, DFHV is authorizing a special event limousine decal for the January 2017 Presidential Inauguration. The owner of a limousine licensed in a jurisdiction outside the District may apply for a decal temporarily authorizing the owner, a for-hire licensed operator, and a for-hire licensed vehicle, to provide point-to-point limousine service in the District. The decal shall not authorize the provision of black car service via app.

II. AUTHORITY

Establishment Act, D.C. OFFICIAL CODE § 50-307(c)(1), (c)(12), (c)(13), and (c)(19); 31 DCMR §§ 701.3 and 1016.1.

III. PROCEDURES:

1. Each limousine owner seeking a 2017 Presidential Inauguration Special Event Limousine Decal shall apply online at www.tinyurl.com/SpecialDecal. The applicant shall provide basic owner, vehicle, and operator information, and other reasonable information to ensure compliance with this administrative issuance, Title 31 DCMR, and other applicable laws, and pay an application fee of one hundred fifty dollars (\$150) per decal. Decals shall be picked up, or mailed via First Class US Mail, as the applicant requests.
2. Each owner and operator of a vehicle for which a 2017 Presidential Inauguration Special Event Decal is issued shall ensure that the decal is at all times displayed in the manner required by the Department, and that the vehicle is operated in compliance with all applicable operating requirements for District-licensed limousines in Title 31 and other applicable laws, including insurance requirements and not taking street hails.
3. Decals shall be effective for five days only: Thursday, January 19, 2017 at 12:01 a.m. to Monday, January 23, 2017 at 12 midnight. Where a vehicle is operated before or after this period, the owner, operator, and vehicle shall be subject to all legal penalties for unlicensed vehicles and unlicensed operators, including fines and impoundment.
